SANTA FE SPRINGS AQUATICS WILL LIMIT ENTRIES TO COMPLY WITH THE 4-HOUR RULE.

POOL: Santa Fe Springs Aquatic Center 10145 Pioneer Blvd., Santa Fe Springs, CA 90670. The competition pool is an outdoor 25-yard by 8 lanes, with a separate warm-up pool. Water depth is 4ft to 7ft. at the start end and 4ft to 11ft at the turn end. The competition course has been certified in accordance with 104.2.2(C)

DIRECTIONS: From the 605 Freeway exit on Telegraph Rd. Go east to Pioneer Blvd. Turn Right on Pioneer Blvd. from the 5 Freeway exit on Pioneer Blvd. Go north on Pioneer Blvd.

HOST NOTES: Timing Reminders: Teams will be assigned timing lanes proportionate to the number of swimmers entered into the meet. Your help and cooperation is appreciated and necessary to keep the meet running smoothly. Santa Fe Springs Aquatics will supply a full service snack bar that will be available throughout the competition. Come hungry!

MEET REFEREE: The Meet Referee shall be in charge of the meet. Any questions regarding the conduct of the meet should be directed to that person.

RULES: USA swimming rules will govern. Current SCS meet procedures will be enforced and take precedence over any errors or omissions on this entry form. See SCS 2010 Swim Guide. Swimmers must swim in their actual Age Group as determined by age on the first day of the meet. Swimmers must check in with the Clerk of Course for each event they wish to swim. After an event has been officially closed a swimmer may not check in or scratch. **Swimmer in the first four events of each session must check in at least 30 minutes prior to the start of that session. 2010 Seasonal USA Swimming members must register for 2011 to compete in this meet.** Open events may be entered by swimmers 11-yrs and older who have achieved the 11-12 “Blue” time for that event. Swimmers 5-8 years old may swim 5-8 events or 5-10 events, not any combination.

SWIMSUITS: for men may not extend above the navel or below the knee and for women may not cover the neck or extend past the shoulders or below the knee; no zippers or other fastening devices are allowed except a waist tie on a brief or jammer; suits must be of textile material (no polyurethane or neoprene). An athlete may wear a single set of garments underneath his or her competition swimsuit for modesty and/or privacy reasons.

WARM UP RULES: Swimmers warming up or down before, after, or during the meet shall be under the direct supervision of a USA member coach. No equipment allowed in the pool at any time during the meet. There will be no diving into the pool at any time during warm ups except in designed sprint lane(s) when announced each day. Swimmers misusing the warm up pool will be removed at the discretion of the Marshal. Warm up rules will be announced and posted.

UNACCOMPANIED ATHLETE: Any swimmer entered in the meet, unaccompanied by a USA Swimming member coach, must be certified by a USA Swimming member coach as being proficient in performing a racing start or must start each race from within the water. It is the responsibility of the swimmer or the swimmer’s legal guardian to ensure compliance with this requirement.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all Metro Committee Athletes who hold a current 2010 or 2011 registration card. Registration application must be received by the Monday prior to the first day of the meet by the meet processor, administrative referee or SCS Office. Late application will be considered on deck. and subject to penalties in SCS Swim Guide, Part One, III, B. In SCS age group meets, swimmers 18 & younger must prove birth dates prior to competition. There are substantial penalties to swimmer & Club (See 2010 SCS Swim Guide, Part One, III, B) if USA Swimming registration is completed at the meet.

CHANGE OF AFFILIATION: Before the meet, a swimmer may change affiliation by submitting a Club transfer form and the appropriate fee to the Swim Office. At the meet, a swimmer may only unattach (may not attach or reattach) by notifying the Administrative Referee and paying the fee.

SUMMITTED TIMES: Times submitted must be the best RECORDED short course yard times from this or the preceding swim season. Swimmers who have achieved “Blue” or “Red” times in an event in long course must enter the “Blue” or “Red” minimum time for that event. If a swimmer does not have a recorded time in the event, **enter N.T. (no time).** Coaches and swimmers should be prepared to verify all submitted times. Falsification of times can lead to disciplinary action. A swimmer may swim an event (stroke/distance) once even if offered twice.

AWARDS: “Blue” DIVISION: Medals 1st – 3rd Ribbons 4th – 8th. “Red” DIVISION: Ribbons 1st – 8th. “White” DIVISION: Ribbons 1st – 8th.
 Relays Ribbons 1st-3rd OPEN events will not receive awards. 13 and Over will be awarded 13-14, and 15- over

ENTRY PROCEDURE: Submit one white SCS entry card for each swimmer. The card must be completely filled out, including the entire USA SWIMMING registration number. \$3.00 for each individual event PLUS \$6.00 surcharge per swimmer must accompany each individual entry card. Relay teams will be entered on deck for a \$5.00 fee. Make checks payable to “**SOUTHERN CALIFORNIA SWIMMING**”. There are no refunds. **RETURNED CHECKS WILL INCUR A SERVICE FEE PER SCS POLICY.** Entries will be rejected if a check does not accompany the entry card. **ENTRIES MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE MEET PROCESSOR NO LATER THAN 5 PM, WEDNESDAY, September 8, 2010. IF THE MEET FILLS PRIOR TO THE DEADLINE, ENTRIES WILL BE REJECTED (LAST RECEIVED, FIRST REJECTED).**

SCS policy for electronic entry: #1 E-mail entry (entry. zip file) will be accepted ONLY when received with an attached Word or .pdf file including electronic signature of coach and will be dated as official at that time. #2 Full payment (single team check) for an e-mail entry must be postmarked within 48 hours of the e-mail entry. Failure to comply will be referred to the Board of Review. #3 Entry updates (added events) will be processed when received by the processor by the entry deadline. Added events (entered swimmers) may be submitted by hard copy (this includes e-mail) ONLY. New swimmers accepted SPACE AVAILABLE. #4 DO NOT RE-SEND AN ENTRY FILE: A replacement file for the team will NOT be processed. Deletions will NOT be refunded.

ENTRY FEE: \$3.00 for each individual event PLUS \$6.00 per swimmer must accompany entry forms. \$5.00 per relay team is due when entered on deck. No Refunds. Returned checks will incur a service fee per SCS policy.
